2018/01/4	<p>Matters Arising from the Minutes/Review of Actions:-</p> <p>2017/12/4 - Cllr Peabody has contacted Street Doctor and Ian Boyes about the damage lorries are causing to the bottom green. There is no money available from the County Council to fix this. Cllr Peabody will look into ways of making good the damage at the Parish Councils expense and ways to deter future damage.</p> <p>Cllr D Smith asked all Councillors to come to the next meeting with ideas for the Spring Clean.</p> <p>2017/12/5.1 - The Clerk has requested a Grit Bin for Emery Close. The application will be considered by the County Council between May-October 2018.</p> <p>2017/12/5.3 - Cllr Peabody has contact Ian Boyes regarding an application for a weight limit in the village. A survey over a 12 hour period, of HGV's going through the village will need to be conducted once the days get longer. Funding is available if a case can be made.</p> <p>2017/12/5.4 The Clerk has reported to Highways that No 17 and 48 Ashby Road are bumping over the grass and damaging it. Lynsey Norman from Highways will conduct a site visit.</p>	ALL
